

APM 7.6 Release Notes June 2011

Features & Fixes (v7.6.0.13, June 2011):

- **iPhone Connect for APM Add-On.** This new add-on feature allows customers to connect their iOS devices directly to the APM kiosk via a standard Apple Dock Connector USB cable. Integration is as seamless and easy-to-use as the iPhone itself — customers simply plug-in their device on the Load Media screen, and the APM automatically detects it and begins loading photos. The iPhone Connect module is bundled with the Facebook Connect module for one low price. Contact your sales rep. for details. (Already purchased the Facebook Connect add-on? You're entitled to a free iPhone Connect license!)

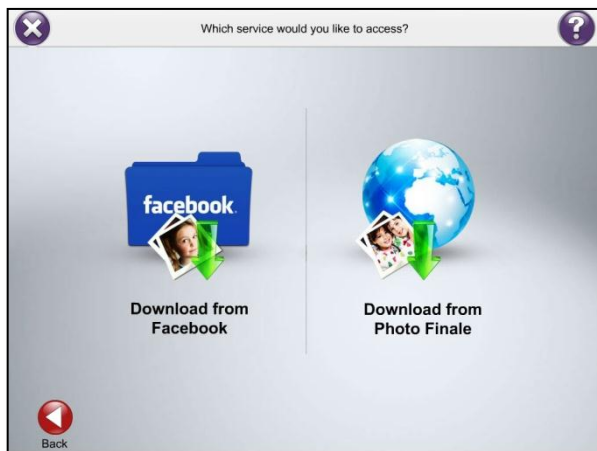
Note: Only photos taken on the device (in the "Camera Roll") are accessible.

- **Facebook Connect.** Added login support for users with "HTTPS" browsing turned on in their Facebook profile. Fixed the "Hide / Show Password" button on the Facebook Upload screen.
- **Style Name Sorting.** The list of available styles within a given category is now sorted alphabetically.
- **Folio Workflow & Rendering.** A number of fixes and improvements, including:
 - Improved rendering in low-memory situations by failing back to lower DPIs if necessary.
 - Fixed support for the "unmoveable" attribute in a folio layout, which is meant to lock an object in place.
 - Fixed an issue with old style ("Creative Collections") greeting cards when they contain text and are then rotated by the customer.
 - Fixed an issue that could set the default font size for a given folio text field too small by default.

- Added support for non-transparent overlays (JPEG only) to be used in folio layouts.
- Updated on-screen, design-time folio rendering to always use `_display` versions of content, regardless of the calculated DPI.

Features & Fixes (v7.5.1.56, January 2011):

- **Facebook Connect for APM Add-on.** This new add-on feature allows customers to access photo currently on Facebook and to upload new photos to their Facebook accounts from the kiosk.. (Contact your Lucidiom sales rep for pricing details.)
 - **Download from Facebook.** Customers can now log in to their Facebook account and select one or more albums to download into the kiosk. Users may then order prints or use the images in any available kiosk product.
 - **Upload to Facebook.** The 2nd part of Facebook Connect for APM allows customers to upload their images (up to 200 at time) from their media to Facebook. The upload option allows both the retailer and the customer several options for sharing the uploaded pictures.




Facebook Download

With Facebook Connect for APM customers can now download their images from their Facebook account and use them to order products.

Facebook Upload

Customers can upload images from their order to Facebook with the option to post a link on their Facebook Wall so that others can re-order prints and gifts.

- **Order Separator.** Added functionality to include the customer's email address on the order separator page that can be configured to print between orders.
- **Membership-Based Discounting.** Lab 50 discounts that are attached to a specific membership plan are now only applied to customers who log into the kiosk and belong to the appropriate membership plan.
- **Kiosk Version and Build Number on Admin Keypad Screen.** The build and version number appear at the bottom of the Admin Keypad screen for quick access.
- **Microsoft .NET 4.** Lab 50 has been updated to take advantage of .NET 4, which includes a number of performance optimizations and low-level bug fixes. The 7.5.1 installer will warn you if you do not have .NET 4 (Full Profile) installed on your machine. - **Email Autofill.** When a customer enters their email address to log into their account, or purchase a Photo Finale or Facebook upload, their email address is automatically copied into the Customer Information screen at the end of the order.
- **New Content Categories Added.** Several new categories were added to further classify the available content for various products.
 - **Anniversary**
 - **Congrats**
 - **Memorial**
 - **Celebrate**
 - **We've Moved**
- **Improved Windows 7 Compatibility for Setup Wizard.** Added code under the hood to prevent the Windows Program Compatibility window from appearing after running the Setup Wizard.
- **Keeps Devices.def file from previous versions.** The updater now keeps any custom devices.def (used for CD-R/DVD-R drive support) file intact instead of replacing it. This prevents cases of having to redo the file after an update.
- **Folio Branding Pricing.** Fixed a bug which resulted in the order receipt showing a charge for an extra page when the Folio Branding engine was configured to add a lab logo page.

- **Noritsu Duplex Printers.** Fixed an issue that would cause the last page (the back) of 7x5 Folded Cards to print upside-down on the Noritsu D502 and D1005 printers.
- **APM Support Reminder.** The APM will now remind you when the support contract for your APM has expired, or is expiring within the next 30 days.
- **Hotfolder Configuration.** Fixed an issue which prevented operators from adding new products to the rendering settings in the Setup Wizard for the Generic Hotfolder printer interface.
- **Customized Product Names.** Product name changes made in the Setup Wizard are now saved to `apmlang_custom.xml` since this is where all product names are pulled (as of v7.5).
- **Premium Content Pricing.** Fixed the quantity pricing table display for premium content products, as well as overall pricing calculations involving premium content.
- **Folio Branding Rendering.** Resolved the issue with the Folio Branding engine which could result in incorrect positioning of a logo element on the final folio output.
- **XConnect Special Instructions.** The Graphx Photogize XConnect printer interface will now transmit "Special Instructions" from the APM / Photo Finale orders to Photogize.
- **DVD Cinema.** Fixed a problem which caused the DVD Cinema product to be unavailable if the kiosk was not configured to also offer the passport product.
- **PrintServer Package Rendering.** Fixed the feature which allows PrintServer to apply package templates to print products on-the-fly (e.g. creating an 8-up wallet from a single photo). In certain circumstances the rendering was failing because of a licensing issue.
- **EQUUpload Logs.** The "Send Logs to Support" feature will now send log files from the EQUUpload and Facebook Connect components, to facilitate remote technical support.
- **Photo IQ Enhancement.** Updates to prevent automatic Photo IQ enhancement of photos which have an EXIF "custom-rendered" flag set, which generally indicates they have been previously retouched.
- **Uneven Pages Warning.** Corrected a warning message that could occur when ordering an upsell of a product that required an even number of pages, while the upsold product does not, if the two products are both in the same style family.
