

# Lab 50 7.5.2 Release Notes March 2011

#### 7.5 Release Notes

### Features & Fixes (v7.5.2.4, June 2011):

- Lab 50 Fixes. A handful of fixes including:
  - Fixed problem which could cause the Product Catalog to fail to load.
  - o Fixed one scenario that caused "no photo" items to appear in orders intermittently.

#### Features & Fixes (v7.5.2.3, March 2011):

- FolioServer Update. A number of improvements and fixes including:
  - Improved low-memory rendering retry logic
  - o Fixes the exported size of a folio product when product and layout dimensions differ
  - Download retry logic added for photo fetches
  - Support for bordering rendering
  - Added support for folio gifting
  - Single photo folio output now respects photo rotations performed by the user
- Lab 50 Fixes. A number of improvements and fixes including:
  - Resolved warning message "Table 'OrderLineItemDiscount' has errors."
  - Prevented empty photo cells from causing export failure
  - Fixed branding ad graphics from swapping spots
  - Fixed view filtering by product

## Features & Fixes (v7.5.1.24, January 2011):

- FolioServer Update. Several improvements, optimizations and fixes for rendering issues in FolioServer that sometimes led to problems with photo rotation, photo cropping, photo positioning, squished/stretched photos, text clipping and text wrapping.
- **Thumbnail Logo.** A new "Thumbnail Logo" type is available for upload in the Brand Settings and Logos screen. The Thumbnail Logo is a small (96x96 or 128x128) square logo that is used for branding Facebook uploads from the APM.



- Order Separator. Added functionality to include the customer's email address on the order separator page that can be configured to print between orders.
- **Noritsu Duplex Printers**. Fixed an issue that would cause the last page (the back) of 7x5 Folded Cards to print upside-down on the Noritsu D502 and D1005 printers.

### Features & Fixes (v7.5.1.7, October 2010):


• Lucidiom-Fulfilled EQ Gifting for Photo Finale 7. With this version of Lab 50, you can now offer the same lineup of EQ Gifting products on your Photo Finale site that are available on the APM.



EQ Gifting is Lucidiom's managed, photo-merchandise fulfillment program that allows retailers to offer over 500 personalized gifting products on their kiosks and Photo Finale site. If you aren't currently enrolled in the program, sign-up is free... just contact your sales rep.

- In-Store Gifting for Photo Finale 7. Labs participating in Lucidiom's EQ Gifting program now also have access through Lab 50 to pick & choose gift products to produce in-house (excluding items with content licensing restrictions, e.g. Disney plates). You must enroll in the EQ Gifting program to take advantage of these locally producible products, but sign-up is free... just contact your sales rep.
- Member Account Credits. User accounts can now be assigned a dollar-value balance in Lab 50. This augments the existing Product Credits feature (e.g. 10 4x6 print credits). A new "Account Credit" tab in the Member Details screen allows an operator to add credit to a member's account, and displays a full transaction history for the user. If a customer has an available Account Credit, it will automatically be applied to their online order as a discount before payment is taken.

(\*Note: Account Credits do not currently apply to APM kiosk orders.)







- Enhanced Discounts & Promotions. Lab 50 and Photo
  Finale now support applying multiple promotions to a
  single order, and the Lab 50 Order Summary screen will
  display a summary of the discounts applied to a given
  order. Order and product discounts and coupons are
  listed individually, and price tier discounts and print
  credits are bundled together as "Other Adjustments."
- Microsoft .NET 4. Lab 50 has been updated to take
   advantage of .NET 4, which includes a number of performance optimizations and low-level bug fixes. The 7.5.1 installer will warn you if you do not have .NET 4 (Full Profile) installed on your machine. The latest version of the .NET Framework can always be found at <a href="http://www.smallestdotnet.com">http://www.smallestdotnet.com</a>.

**APM Support Reminder.** Lab 50 will now remind you





- Fixed rendering issues in FolioServer and Photo Finale 7 that sometimes led to squished/stretched photos, especially when dealing with photos that have an in-camera orientation flag set, as well as photos that the user rotated/zoomed/panned online.
- Fixed the problem that prevented operators from deleting certain product catalogs.
- Fixed the problem that prevented APM orders from being "Exported" (rather than printed)
  when they included a custom dealer product which does not exist in the dealer's product
  catalog.
- Fixed an issue with category previews not being copied when importing from a supplier catalog.
- Fixed an issue that might misreport the number of codes assigned to a Coupon Campaign.



- Fixed an aesthetic issue in the Print dialog which would not display the thumbnail for gifting items ordered from the older Photo Finale v6 site.
- Fixed support for custom APM products configured in an apmconfig products custom.xml file.
- The Graphx Photogize XConnect printer interface will now transmit "Special Instructions" from the APM / Photo Finale orders to Photogize.
- Fixed an issue which prevented operators from adding new products to the rendering settings in the Setup Wizard for the Generic Hotfolder printer interface.
