

# Wrapping Paper Installer and Setup

Thank you for purchasing the Wrapping Paper Add-On for the APM. We have setup your Lucidiom Downloader tool to ease the installation of this license and content. In the Lucidiom Downloader, click the Update List button, and you will see the Wrapping Paper Installer listed.

## Lucidiom Downloader:

Don't yet have the Lucidiom Downloader? It can be downloaded from the following: <http://www.lucidiom.com/support/LucidiomDownloader.exe>

Just install the Lucidiom Downloader on one of your machines – an APM, one of your office computers, or even a laptop or home machine. Once you've downloaded the data there, use your local area network (LAN), a removable USB hard drive, or DVD-Rs to copy and distribute the content to each of your APMs.

If you install the tool on a machine other than an APM, the first time you run it you'll be asked for your APM ID and version number. Enter the APM ID from one of your kiosks, and enter "7.0.0" for the version number.

## To download the Wrapping Paper:

1. Click on the Update List button. All available downloads will appear in the "Available Downloads" list.
2. Select the Wrapping Paper Installation file, and click the Begin Download button.
3. The download will move to the "Downloads" list where you can monitor progress. You can quit the Download tool, reboot your machine, play games, or get work done while the tool continues to download the jobs you've selected in the background.

By default, the content will be downloaded to your computer's desktop. The file will only appear on the desktop once the download is complete.
