Touch Screen Settings for APM 2002 & 2700

Touch screen sensitivity may be adjusted by making changes to the settings in the touch screen driver on the machine. To do this, go to the **Start Menu > Programs > Touch Utility**, and open the Touch Utility application. From there, select the "Parameter" tab, and ensure that the preferences are set as outlined in this screenshot:
